

April 21 - 27, 2024

Virginia stands at the top of our rankings of fascinating southern states that have the punch to back up their amazing historical legacies, and this springtime trip will show off that "punch." We'll spend an entire week exploring Virginia's flatter, bucolic landscapes that spill east to the Chesapeake Bay then melt into it. Our drive will take us through beautiful "Southside Virginia," entering and departing the state with one overnight each direction. We'll spend two nights in the heart of Colonial

Williamsburg and then two nights on the Northern Neck at the acclaimed Hope and Glory Inn. The trip will feature historic homes and their stories, decorative arts, Revolutionary War history, and the Chesapeake "way of life."

WHERE DOES AN EXPLORE UP **CLOSE TRIP BEGIN?**

For our Southeastern trips, we will arrange pick-up either from your home or from a convenient location, depending on our trip itinerary. For our domestic and international trips that involve a flight, our group will meet at the airport or at our destination airport / hotel.

DEPOSIT PAYMENTS

To reserve a trip, Explore Up Close requires a \$500 per person deposit for domestic trips, and a \$1,000 per person deposit for international trips. Payment of the remaining balance is due 30 days prior to departure for domestic trips and 90 days prior to departure for international trips.

SCENIC BACKROADS TO PITTSBURGH May 19 - 25, 2024

Join us for our second pilgrimage to Pittsburgh—stunning in its stories of interest and wealth of knowledge from great guides to help us in our explorations there. And Pittsburgh is just one part of the outstanding trifecta of facets to this adventure. We'll make a cirque route that takes us to Zion National Park (featuring lodging inside the park at the Zion Lodge), to the Bryce Canyon / Grand Staircase area (our lodging features a "backdoor" entrance into Bryce Canyon!), over Boulder Mountain to the Capitol Reef area, and then back to St. George, Utah. We'll also soak in the phenomenal dark skies at night, remarkable views from our inns, and fascinating histories of the Native Americans and Mormon pioneers.

CHILE + PATAGONIA


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March 6 - 18, 2024

Ahhh, this is the perfect trip. We'll enjoy multiple nights in two of Chile's premier wine-producing regions, lodging in two distinct hotels-one known for recapturing the refinement of its historic estate and the other nestled in a mountain-ringed valley. They are casual in style with a swimming pool this way, an easy walk to a great local restaurant that way, and the Laura Hartwig Winery just through the field and gate. After visiting these two distinguished places (Casablanca and Colchagua), we will retreat to the sunny and unique Santiago. Then we fly south-all the way south-to the world's foremost name in outdoor, natural drama: Patagonia. There, we'll spend three nights on Lago Grey (at the Lago Grey Hotel); explore the serene beauty of the Torres del Paine and its soaring peaks, lakes, glaciers, and wildlife; and benefit from guided excursions and well-prepared meals. We'll live it!

It's July, so that must mean that idyllic Quebec is calling our names. What a stunning place! That's why we return to one of our favorite Quebec itineraries. Beginning and ending in Quebec City - famously European in form and heritage - we'll drive downriver on the bucolic north shore of the St. Lawrence River. Our route is marvelously squeezed between the mountainous outback of Jacques Cartier National Park and the river itself, leading us by farms producing fruits and berries, traditional villages-turned-artist colonies, rich fir forests, and the presence of the river. We'll explore two of St. Lawrence's islands: the Ile aux Coudres and the larger Ile St. Louis. Eventually, we'll reach the Hudson's Bay Company headquarters (think 1864 HQ), where the Saguenay River empties into the St. Lawrence—one of the world's best whale-watching places.


